Please get in contact if there is any information you would like from any of us, regarding the training or school in general.

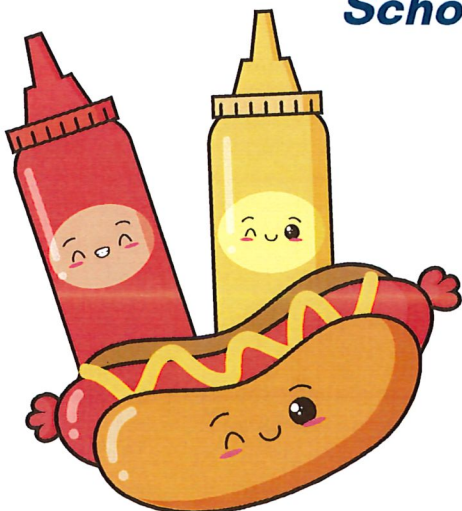

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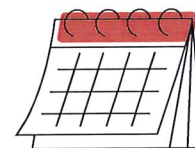


THE CAT IN THE HAT IS COMING TO TOWN.
