## Referendum – Cake Stall

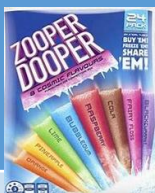

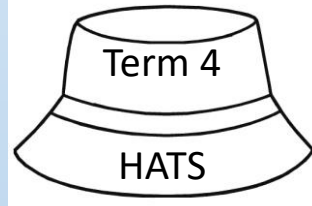
